Think about...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Skin/scales/fur/hair</li> <li>• Eyes</li> <li>• Teeth</li> <li>• Colour</li> </ul> <p>Can you write a sentence about each part of your Wild Thing? Can you give it a name?</p> <p>(English)</p>	<p>Money Can you find some coins at home? Can you order the coins according to their value? Can you add two coins to make amounts? You might enjoy creating a shop with some items. Could you buy an item from your shop with a 10p or 20p coin? How much change would you get?</p> <p>(Maths)</p>	<p>Seasons Can you draw and write about each season? Can you put the seasons in order? <p>Weather Can you keep a log of the weather over three or four days? Can you record using the correct symbols? How does it change over the three or four days?</p> <p>(Geography)</p>

We ask that one task is completed per week (you don't have to do all six!) and that you initial and date each activity completed.
