


How many altogether?</p>  <p>6 equal groups of 2 $6 \times 2 = 12$</p> <p>(Maths)</p>	<p>Plants</p> <p>Can you go on a Spring walk in your area or in your garden?</p> <p>Can you see how many wild or garden plants you can identify?</p> <p>Could you take photographs of the plants you identify?</p> <p>Could you draw any of them?</p> <p>Can you add any labels to your drawings?</p> <p>(Science)</p>
