



<p>Book- The Secret Sky Garden</p> <p>Write about one of your friends. Include: their name, what they like doing and why they are your friend. This could be someone from school or someone in your family. You can also draw a picture of them.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Think about litter (rubbish) where you live.</p> <p>How does this make you feel? What could be done about this?</p> <p>Write some sentences about this or you could make a poster about this.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Explore your garden or a different outdoor area. Look at the flowers and other plants. What colours can you see? What sounds can you hear? How does it make you feel?</p> <p>Write some super sentences describing these things. You might include some interesting adjectives and verbs.</p> <p>(English)</p>	<p>Place value (within 20) Addition and subtraction (within 20)</p> <p>Look at 2 digit numbers together and discuss how many tens and ones in those numbers. What will it need? Where will you plant it? Will it grow? How long will it take?</p> <p>(Science)</p>
