## Prior Knowledge

- Explore printing simple pictures with a range of hard and soft materials e.g. cork, pen, barrels, sponge
- Experience impressed printing e.g. printing from objects

- Explore printing in relief e.g. string and card
- Begin to identify forms of printing : books, posters, pictures, fabrics
- Use printmaking to create a repeating pattern

William Morris	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• William Morris was born in England on 24th March, 1834                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He died in 1896</li> </ul> </li> <li>• He became a poet, artist and manufacturer</li> <li>• He made stained glass windows wallpaper and tapestries                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He was inspired by plants and flowers</li> </ul> </li> <li>• His designs had floral patterns using block printing to repeat these designs</li> <li>• These were then made and repeated using printing machines</li> </ul>
Mono-printing	Use mono-printing to create a print inspired by nature (plants) or even using plants/natural objects
Impressed printing	Use a printing block (potato) to print an image

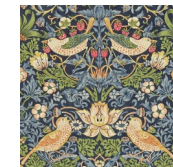

## Key Vocabulary

printing	Transferring images onto different surfaces
Impressed printing	When the printing block is created by carving out the surface.
Mono-printing	This method of printing is to make unique prints. <b>Draw patterns, shapes and designs directly onto an inked surface, usually an acrylic sheet.</b> Gently lay a piece of paper on top of the inked surface to pick up the design.
Other words linked to printing:	Press, roll, design, effect, print, layer, techniques
