Salvador Dali	<p><b>Be able to explain:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Salvador Dalí was born in 1904 in Figueres, Spain (a small town outside Barcelona )</li> <li>He was a surrealist artist</li> <li>He was inspired by Pablo Picasso and other surrealist artists</li> </ul> 
Drawing	<p>Be able to use different grades of pencils to achieve a variation in tone</p>
3d drawing	<p>Show some awareness of 3d dimensions and perspective in their drawings</p>

<u>Key Vocabulary</u>	
surrealist	The word 'surrealist' means 'beyond reality'. This means that surrealist art is an expression of dreams and the unreal rather than something that is true and rational.
shades	Where an artist adds black to a colour to darken it down
tones	How light or dark something is Areas with lots of light are called highlights Darker areas are called shadows

**Artist: Salvador Dali (focus on drawings)**

Dali used the images from his dreams and in his subconscious to improve his creativity.

His most famous piece of art is called 'The Persistence of Memory' (painting)
