Be able to	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use wire to create a 2d sculpture • After they have practiced using wire and looked at some of the artist’s work design their 2d sculpture (draw it) • Finish with adding beads and other collage materials if they decide to add detail • Talk about their work • Talk a little bit about the artist’s work • Once a light is shone onto the sculpture discuss what effect it has and what they can see

Key Vocabulary

Sculptures	The action or art of making statues by carving or chiselling (as in wood or stone), by modeling (as in clay), or by casting (as in melted metal) Lots of other materials can also be used to create sculptures
Sculptor	An artist who makes sculptures
shape	An element of art that is two-dimensional, flat, or limited to height and width.
Other vocabulary	Sculpt, join, structure, shape, shadow, light, twist

Gavin Worth—wire sculptor (2d)

He creates two dimensional sculptures that appear as illustrated line drawings. Some of his artworks are meant to be viewed through projected light and the shadows it creates, while others offer a different story based on the weather changes.
