Dear Parents and Carers

Firstly, I would like to thank you for your overwhelming response to the parent questionnaire which closed on Monday. 126 parents completed the survey and I thank you for taking the time to provide us with this valuable feedback. I have already shared the results with staff and will also share them with governors at the next meeting of the full governing board. The survey highlighted parents' appreciation of the hard work which staff do every day to provide your children with the very best learning opportunities, and on behalf of the staff, I sincerely thank you for this acknowledgment. The results of the questionnaire will be used to inform the school development plan as we continually strive to improve and develop all aspects of school life.

This week Y5 and Y6 representatives from the school council carried out a traffic survey in Bell Close to monitor the impact of the School Streets Pilot Scheme. Pupils were accompanied by Mr Reed and our travel planning committee, which consists of 3 of our governors: Dave Marshall, Tom Wilkinson and Sam Wooley.

The travel committee have been instrumental in the roll out of the School Street Pilot scheme and aim to drive it forward, improving the safety of our school community.
