Dinner Money Increase from September 2024 it will be necessary to increase the price that we charge for a school meal. This is due to a price increase from the catering company that the school uses, NYES Catering. The new price for a school meal will be $\pounds 3.46$ (£17.30 per week).

Attendance – Unfortunately, we haven't quite met our target attendance figure of 96%. However, we finish the year above the national primary school figure of 94.5%. Please note, that the DfE are imposing even tighter rules and tougher fines around attendance next year which you may need to take into consideration if you are planning a holiday during term time. All applications which have already been received for the next academic year will be processed once the updated guidance comes into force.
