**SUN SAFETY** We are all certainly enjoying the sunshine at the moment, but it is important that we all take steps to keep ourselves and our children safe. In school we educate children about sun safety; reduce the amount of time children are outside during periods of exceptionally hot weather; and ensure that children have access to drinking water throughout the day. We also request that you help by taking the following steps:

- Apply sun cream to your child before they arrive at school (SPF 30+ and 4-star+ UVA protection).
- If your child brings sun cream into school so that they can top up at lunchtime, please ensure the bottle is labelled with your child's name.
- Always pack a sunhat.
- Ensure your child brings a reusable water bottle.
