SCHOOL ATTENDANCE As the new school year approaches, I would like to remind parents of the importance of good school attendance and rules around unauthorised holiday absence.

This academic year, we have seen a significant increase in the number of unauthorised holidays. The effects of the pandemic have clearly been a factor in this. However, from September this will no longer be considered.

There is a clear link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement. Regular attendance and punctuality is important and children who frequently miss school often fall behind with their work because they fail to learn the basics which are built upon later.

Unauthorised Holiday & Penalty Notices North Yorkshire LA's Code of Conduct for the use of Penalty Notices states that unauthorised leave of absence can be accumulated over a period of 4 months but must meet the threshold of 10 sessions (5 days) for a Penalty Notice to be issued. Head teachers may refuse any leave of absence during term time unless there are "exceptional circumstances". Parents should avoid booking family holidays during term-time. If this is unavoidable, they should arrange to discuss the matter with school and complete an **Application for pupil leave of absence form** available from the school office. Permission for such absences is not given automatically and unauthorised absences may be referred to the Local Authority and result in a fixed penalty notice.

- No holidays are authorised without exceptional circumstances.
- Penalty notices are issued for absences over 10 sessions (5 school days) in one academic year.

Illness: The child's primary carer must contact the school by telephone on the first day of sickness. Longer absences should be supported by a GP sickness certificate.

Medical Appointments: Absence can be authorised by the school for medical or dental appointments during the school day. However, every effort must be made to try to make these appointments outside of school time. Every appointment during the school day is logged on your child's attendance record.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time, that holidays are not taken in term time and that hospital, doctor and dental appointments are made outside school hours where possible.
