SCHOOL ABSENCE North Yorkshire LA's Code of Conduct for the use of Penalty Notices states that unauthorised leave of absence can be accumulated over a period of 4 months but must meet the threshold of 10 sessions (5 days) for a Penalty Notice to be issued. Head teachers may refuse any leave of absence during term time unless there are "exceptional circumstances". Parents should avoid booking family holidays during term-time. If this is unavoidable, they should arrange to discuss the matter with school and complete an **Application for pupil leave of absence form** available from the school office. Permission for such absences is not given automatically and unauthorised absences may be referred to the Local Authority and result in a fixed penalty notice.

- No holidays are authorised without exceptional circumstances.
- Penalty notices are issued for absences over 10 sessions (5 school days) in one academic year.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time, that holidays are not taken in term time and that hospital, doctor and dental appointments are made outside school hours where possible.
