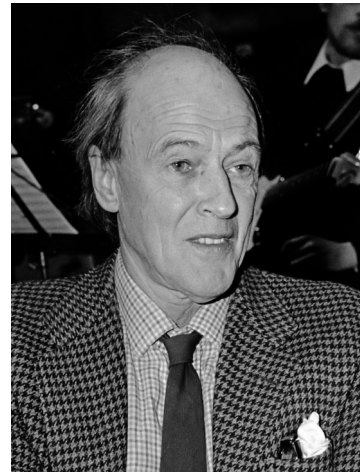
Welcome to your new school newspaper, written for the pupils, by the pupils—teachers are always welcome to read too.

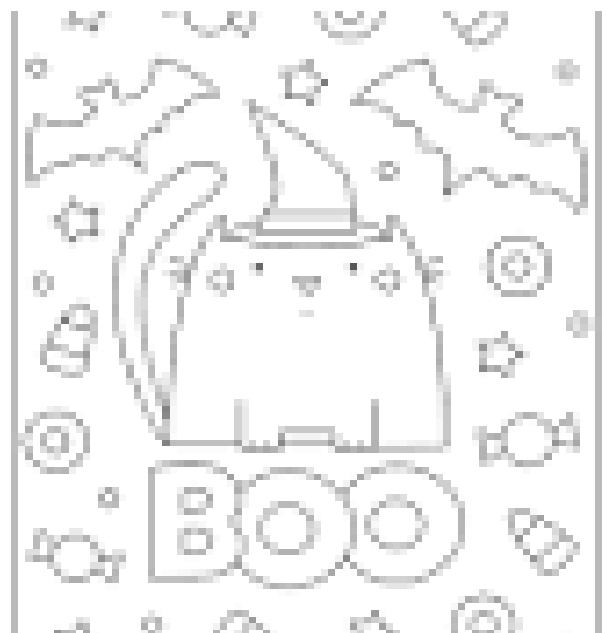
