

Bubble Management for September 2020

The children will be organised in Year group bubbles.

- Children can come into classrooms **from 8.40**. As a result, Staff will be in Classrooms from that time.
- Y4: will enter via fire doors.

All children to wash /sanitise hands on entry to class.

- Register to be taken at 9 am
- Y4 playtimes will be 10.15-10.30am and 2.15-2.30pm.

Children will be given a zone on the playground/field to stay in all week. Please don't venture from your zone.

There will be no snacks available from kitchen. Children should bring healthy(!) snacks.

All children to toilet and wash /sanitise hands on exit from and re-entry to class.

To avoid bubbles meeting in cloakroom/ toilet, please follow 'Knock, check, enter if empty' rule.

Lunchtimes

Morning lessons will finish at 12 midday and MSAs will cover children over lunchtime.

Y4 will be outside from 12 until 12.30 they will then eat in their classrooms from 12.35 to 1.05pm.

Staff will be in place to take charge of children at 1.05pm.

All children wash/sanitise hands before eating and on re-entry into classroom.

There will be no hot dinners for children. "Pack ups" will be available. The children will need to make a choice of Sandwich filling and fruit at register.

End of School arrangements

Y4: will leave via fire doors and be led out through the main green gates **for 3.25pm**

Other information

- There will be no clubs for the first three weeks. This will be reviewed.
- A box for children returning reading books so they can be cleaned has been provided. Colour band reading books will be 'quarantined' for 72 hours before being replaced on the shelves for children to choose. Please feel free to read books from home if your child finishes their colour band book. Book changing days will only be on Mondays and Thursdays.
