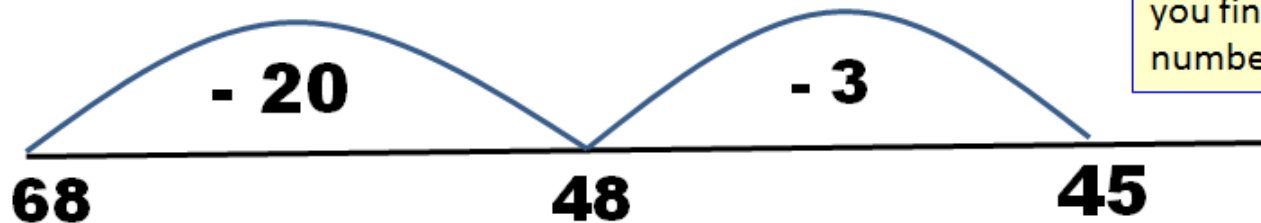


SUBTRACTION USING A NUMBER LINE

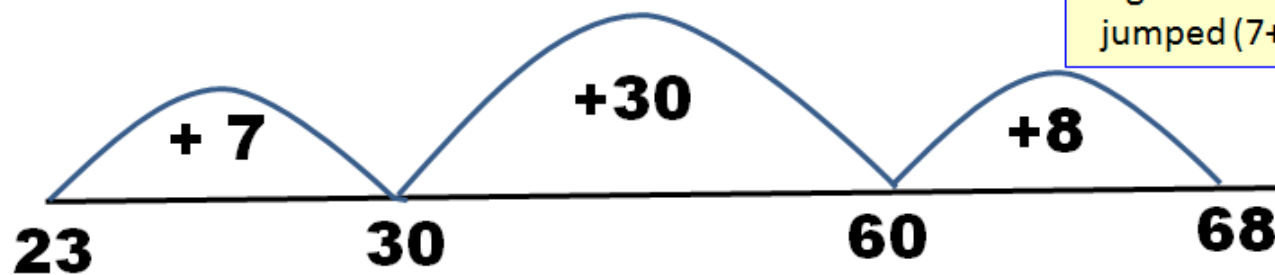
$$68 - 23 =$$

Counting backwards



The answer is where you finish on the number line.

Counting on to find the difference.



Add the numbers together that you have jumped ($7+30+8 = 45$)

SUBTRACTION USING COLUMN SUBTRACTION

- Keep columns in line.
- Always start with the units.
- If you are unable to subtract the digits **borrow** from the left.
- Don't forget to **carry** the units you have.
- Always work from right to left.

One ten was borrowed from the tens column so 9 tens now becomes 8 tens

6 - 9 is not possible so borrow one ten from the tens column and place a 1 next to the 6 to show $16 - 9 = 7$
