1 July 2020

I hope this letter finds you fit and well.

It has been lovely to welcome our Y6 pupils back to school this week – they have grown so much! Together with the key worker and vulnerable groups the school is operating at its current maximum capacity under the existing risk assessment. We will be re-introducing the EYFS pupils from Monday 6 July and are planning for all year groups to return in September 2020. This, of course, is still subject to government and public health guidance.

REPORTS You should receive your child's annual school report with this letter. It will indicate which class and teacher they have been allocated for next year. You can find out more about your child's new class by visiting their class webpage.

PHOTOGRAPHS The class and team photographs that were taken in March will not be ready for collection before the end of term as Tempest have furloughed their staff. They should be available in September and we will contact you when arrangements have been made.

SCHOOL MEALS We have been running a packed lunch only school dinner during the lockdown period. This will continue except for a Y6 Leavers' Lunch we have planned for Friday 3 July and a Fish and Chips day on Thursday 9 July. There will be no school packed lunch option on these days. If your child is in school, as part of the key worker or EYFS groups, they can also have the hot meal option. Pupils entitled to Free School Meals will continue to receive the EdenRed vouchers throughout the summer break.
