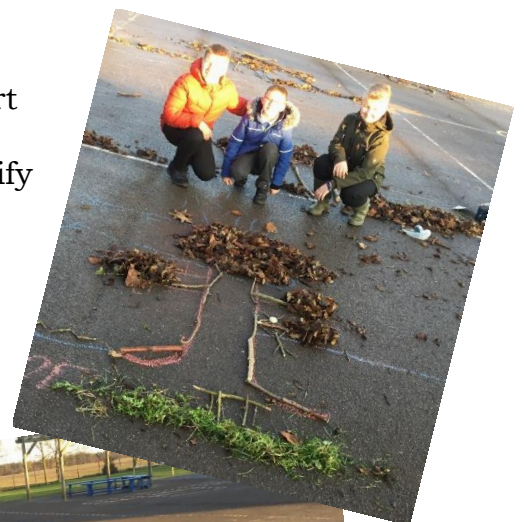

PE POLICY Physical Education (PE) contributes to the overall education of all children by helping them to lead full and valuable lives through engaging in purposeful and high-quality activity. It promotes active and healthy lifestyles, physical skills, physical development and knowledge of the body in action. Everyone has a duty to ensure PE activities are carried out with due regard to the safety of staff and pupils. We ask for your support in the following areas:

JEWELLERY

- All jewellery should be removed and stored safely before each lesson. Ideally, leave your jewellery at home.
- If children wear stud earrings they should be taken out by the child. If this is not possible, the child should be given tape to cover their earrings. Children must place and remove the tape independently.
- All long hair should be tied back.

CLOTHING

- Suitable clothing should be worn for each lesson. Children should not engage in physical activity without correct kit. This will include; blue PE T-Shirt, blue shorts, jogging bottoms for colder weather, socks and trainers.
- Children should be prepared for indoor and outdoor sessions each week – leave the kit at school and take it home for washing at the end of each half term.
