Work is required to the school boilers and the chimney that acts as a flue. In preparation for this work we are closing the KS1 outdoor area. This will effect the end of day collection arrangements for some classes.

YEAR 1 If your child is in Y1 could you go round through the main gates, up the ramp to the right of Mr Reed's classroom and wait on the playground where the children usually line in the morning. Staff will watch out for you and send the children out to the playground. Please leave the same way you came in.

BEECH CLASS If your child is in Beech class (Miss Chapman) please go round through the main gate and wait outside the classroom near the classroom fire door. Your child will be released to you as you are seen. Please leave the same way you came in.

CHESTNUT CLASS If your child is in Chestnut class (Mrs Knowles/Mr Caffrey) please go round through the main gate and wait outside the classroom near the classroom fire door, behind Mr Reed's class. Your child will be released to you as you are seen. Please leave the same way you came in.

All KS2 classes at the rear of the school (JR, RW, PM, SS and SR) will need to leave school using the rear fire doors and staff escort the children via the ramp (SR) to leave through the main green gate. Parents will need to wait in the area near the main school entrance.

All other classes will leave the school as usual.
