**ROAD SAFETY** The safety of the children in our care is paramount. Therefore, I take very seriously the dangers posed to the children by thoughtless driving and parking around the school.

In particular, can I remind you:

- We operate a voluntary one-way system around Denison Avenue.
- Parents should avoid driving into Bell Close if at all possible.
- The Mayfield Hotel is an ideal option to 'park and stride' – a seven minute walk.
- Cars should not pull up on paths or park around or opposite the school entrance.
- Only authorised vehicles are allowed on the school premises and car parks.
